

## Lesson 1: Earning

This Google Slide Word Wall introduces students to the vocabulary used in the lesson and the definitions. Click on the upper right hand corner for “present” mode to have the word wall function as flip cards.</li> </ol>

Have students watch <b>some or part</b> of the read aloud chapter book that shows students how doing jobs earn income.</li> </ol>

Present the Google Slides worksheet to the students. As a class, have students decide which jobs requires a bachelor’s degree and which jobs require a graduate degree.
