<p><b>Part 1: Introduction</b> <i>Video: Introduction</i> <a href="#">G3-L8-Part1</a></p>	<p>1. Begin the lesson by watching this quick review and introduction to the lesson and word wall.</p>
<p><b>Part 2: Word Wall-Vocabulary</b> <a href="#">G3-L8-Word-Wall</a></p>	<p>1. This Google Slide Word Wall introduces students to the vocabulary used in the lesson and the definitions. Click on the upper right hand corner for "present" mode to have the word wall function as flip cards.</p>

This optional 3 question quiz will assess the understanding of the concepts in the video. You can use this to help guide your questions following the video with your students.</p>
<p><b>Part 5: Group Activity</b>  <a href="#">G3-L8-IC</a></p>	<p>1. As a class, play the “Thumbs up, Thumbs Down” game. As you show each category on the screen, students either give a “thumbs up” if they think the information is ok to share, or a “thumbs down” if they think it is not ok to share. Discuss why after each one to further assess for understanding.</p>
